NOTICE OF RACE

Notice of Race

This is the Notice of Race for the Second Sailstice Novice Regatta 2020 for the 20th Anniversary of the Summer Sailstice hosted by North Sea Racing and shipwright, Bandit. This race will be hosted on Saturday 20th June from 2:00PM SLT to 4:00PM SLT and is intended for sailors new to Second Life Sailing who will receive sponsorship from Bandit in the form of the Bandit 22 LTE yacht for the purpose of participating in this regatta. This regatta will run four races from the North Sea and will be scored with the low point system. Please see below for details.

1 RULES

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *SL-WS Adjusted Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020*.

1.5 Under SL-WS ARRS 87, rule dictating the use of one boat class (Bandit 22 LTE) will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

1.1 No advertising rules apply to this regatta.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 This regatta is open to boats of the Bandit 22 LTE class that are skippered by novice sailors.

3.2 Eligible sailors may enter by signing up on the Summer Sailstice website for the event here: <https://summersailstice.com/event/summer-sailstice-second-life>

3.3 Late entries may be accepted under the following conditions:

- Race Director (Cryptic) is approached and asked.
- Sailor is new to Second Life sailing.
- Approval by Cryptic and Analyse Dean
- Restrictions under 3.4 are followed.

3.4 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply:

- A maximum number of 20 boats may be entered in this series.

4 CLASSIFICATION

The following classification requirements will apply (see SL-WS ARRS 79):

- The sailor is new to Second Life Sailing
- The sailor has been approved to race this regatta by the Race Committee.

7.2 Equipment

Upon confirmed registration, the sailor will be sponsored with a Bandit 22 LTE to practice.

7.3 Dates of Racing

20/06/2020 – Class: Bandit 22 LTE

7.4 Number of Races

Class: Bandit 22 LTE – Number: 4 – Races per day: 4

7.5 The scheduled time for the warning signal for the first race is 2:00PM SLT.

7.6 No warning signal will be made after 3:45pm SLT on 20/06/2020.

8 MEASUREMENT

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be made available after 15/06/2020 at the *Sail Virtual* website (www.sailvirtual.com).

10 VENUE

10.1 The location of the race will be the race line at the Eden Curlew sim.

10.2 Attachment 1 shows the location of the racing areas.

11 THE COURSES

The diagrams in **Attachment 1** show the course to be sailed in each race of this series, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. The course is a Windward/Leeward course utilising gate marks as depicted by the diagram in **Attachment 1**.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 The Scoring Penalty, SL-WS ARRS 44.3, will apply. The penalty will be one place per incident.

12.2 For the Bandit 22 LTE class SL-WS ARRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

12.3 Decisions of the protest committee and race committee will be final as provided in SL-WS ARRS 70.5.

13 SCORING

13.1 The scoring system will be the Low Point system as described in SL-WS ARRS APPENDIX A.

13.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.3 (a) when fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 3 to 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

14 SUPPORT BOATS

There will be no support boats.

15 BERTHING
